\_\_\_\_\_ Very knowledgeable about the topic/ person (10pts.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Provide at least 10 interesting details about the topic/ person (20pts.)

\_\_\_\_\_ **NEVER, NEVER, NEVER tell the ending of the book!!!** (5pts.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Leave the listener “hooked”. (5pts.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Tell who would be interested in reading the book. (5pts.)

*(I recommend this book to...)*

\_\_\_\_\_ You were prepared, organized, and calm. Good eye contact. (12pts.)

\_\_\_\_\_ You were fast enough, loud enough, and sounded enthusiastic about the book. (9pts.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Tell books that your author has written. (BONUS +2)
